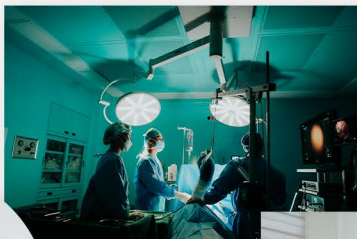


Domestic & Global Visiting Surgeon Program in Shoulder Treatment

Q What is the Visiting Surgeon Program?

The Visiting Surgeon Program is designed to provide orthopedic surgeons with the opportunity to learn from other surgeons in a hospital setting. The program focuses on sharing and learning knowledge and skills in surgical and non-surgical shoulder treatments. Visiting surgeons include orthopedic surgeons in South Korea and outside of South Korea. The duration of the program varies from one day to several weeks depending on the participant's situation. Through the program, the visiting surgeons will participate in the following activities:

- Observe outpatient clinics in orthopedic surgery.
- Observe live shoulder surgery.
- Practice arthroscopic shoulder surgery techniques with a shoulder training model.
- Discuss surgical options, procedures, techniques, and devices to treat shoulder diseases.
- Participate in a certification ceremony and receive a certificate of completion.



Who Hosts the Program?

The program is hosted by Narsha hospital. Narsha Hospital is an orthopedic hospital specialized in shoulder treatment with a 13-story facility and Narsha Shoulder Research Center.
